Dear Customer:

Effective immediately, Delta Cargo cannot accept shipments containing devices powered by lithium batteries, regardless of the amount of lithium contained. Such devices include but are not limited to some data loggers attached to temperature sensitive shipments. Delta Air Lines, Inc. has been advised by the FAA and the US Department of Transportation Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) that the use of such devices containing any amount of lithium must be approved before being carried aboard passenger flights in order to ensure the safety of the passengers, crew and aircraft.

In order to get the appropriate approval for the data logger itself (specific to the device being used) to be used in air transport a specific Competent Authority approval must be authorized by PHMSA per 49 CFR 107.705. In addition, the manufacturer must provide documentation showing the specific devices do not cause electronic interference.
