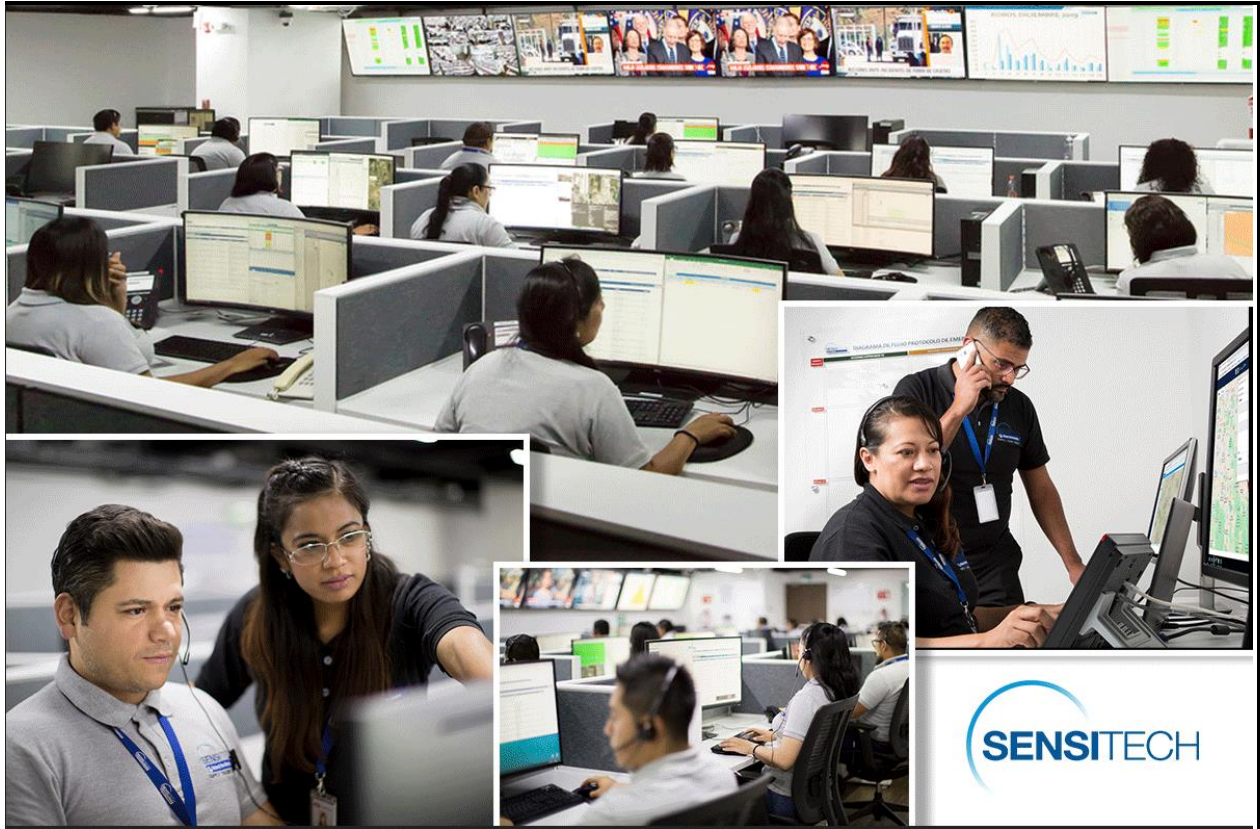




SENSITECH ANNOUNCES NORTH & SOUTH AMERICA CARGO SECURITY EXPANSION
